NEW AUBERTIN ORGAN

St John's College normally has at least two Organ Scholars in residence, alongside a Kendrew (graduate) music student, eight Choral Scholars and auditioned choir, a professional musician in residence, and a Tutorial Fellow in Music.

Music flourishes generally at St John's, with an active Music Society, regular professional and student concerts, and superb facilities, including a 200-seat auditorium. The choir sings Evensong twice a week, and has recently toured Sweden, France, Ireland, the USA and South Africa. We have commissioned several new works, including a new Anthem for St John the Baptist by Arvo Pärt, all available on our CD, *St John the Baptist* (Cantoris 2005).
