GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS

Four Graduate Scholarships are available at St John's College from 1st October 2009. The awards are intended to assist students, of proven outstanding academic excellence, who are starting a research degree from October 2009. Those applying for taught courses will not be eligible to apply.

These Graduate Scholarships will be split into two rounds, as follows;

Round One

- All subjects in the Division of Medical Sciences
- All subjects in the Division of Mathematical, Physical & Life Sciences (excluding Mathematics and Physics)
- Subjects offered by the Centre for the Environment

Applications must be received by the college by 23rd January 2009.

Round Two

- All subjects in the Division of Humanities
- All subjects in the Division of Social Sciences (excluding the Centre for the Environment)
- Subjects offered by the Mathematical Institute and the Department of Physics

Applications must be received by the college by 13th March 2009.

The Graduate Scholarships are available to the following classes of applicants;

- Final year St John's undergraduate students.
- Individuals who have completed an undergraduate and/or a masters course at St John's but not yet started a doctorate.
- Undergraduates and graduates from outside St John's College wishing to pursue a D.Phil under the full supervision of a Fellow of St John's.

Applicants for these Graduate Scholarships must also meet with the following requirements;

- Applicants applying to **Round One**, must have submitted a complete application for Graduate Admission to Oxford University by no later than the 23rd January 2009 deadline.
- Applicants applying to **Round Two**, must have submitted a complete application for Graduate Admission to Oxford University by no later than the 13th March deadline.

VALUE

The awards will be for a period of up to four (4) years and will cover living costs (at the level and patterns recommended by the relevant UK research Councils, currently £12,950 per annum), the College fee and the University fee for Humanities, Science or Medicine as appropriate at the UK/Home rate. Overseas student from outside the EU will need to secure additional funds to cover the significant difference in costs between 'UK/Home' and 'Overseas' rates.

Successful applicants would be required, as part of their application, to ensure that the Department hosting their award would provide necessary research expenses. The College would not fund the latter although the scholars would be entitled to apply for Academic Grants and Special Grants subject to the usual rules.

SELECTION

Selection will be by application form and the submission of supporting materials, including three references, as outlined below. There will be no interview.

- Six copies of your completed Graduate Studentship application form.
- Six Copies of a Curriculum Vitae (CV) or Resumé.
- Six copies of your Research Proposal, consisting of no more than 1,000 words.
- Six copies of your Academic Transcript(s).
- Three academic references should either be enclosed with your application, or, you should arrange for them to be sent directly to the Tutor for Graduates' Secretary.
- One copy of the College Ethnic Monitoring Form (optional).

The outcome of the awards will be announced at the end of March (round one) and end of June (round two).
