1. Minutes and matters arising

The minutes of the meeting of Governing Body held on 8th March 2023 were **approved**.

In matters arising the President noted that she and Professor Toussaert would sit on the appointment panel for the Sanjaya Lall Visiting Professorship of Business and Development for the 2023/24 academic year.
