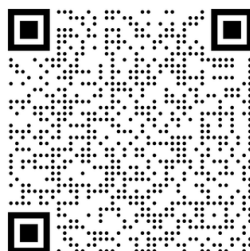
REGISTRATION NOW OPEN UNTIL 13TH DECEMBER 2023
