5. JCR President's Valedictory Address

Ms. Heywood offered her thanks to all the members of College who had supported the JCR over the past year. She also thanked her predecessors as JCR President for their support.

The past year had been more about navigating challenges than about making groundbreaking changes. She was grateful for Governing Body's agreement for a College Ball in 2026 and thanked Professor Jones for his advice. She noted that JCR participation had been reinvigorated across a number of area, including attendance at guest night dinners, participation in elections, and the use of charity funds.

Ms. Heywood noted the work that was still to be done on the inequalities across Oxford that had been noted in the SU's College Disparities Report and looked forward to the progress of the Masterplan.

On behalf of Governing Body, the President thanked the JCR President for her enthusiasm and ability to encourage people to think in different ways. She also thanked the outgoing JCR committee for their hard work over the past year.
