2. Tuition fees, waivers and bursaries

There was general discussion on the papers that had been circulated. The JCR and MCR Presidents commented, and the Principal Bursar explained aspects of the proposals for fees, fee waivers and maintenance bursaries. Debt aversion among students from lower income backgrounds was felt to be a likely serious obstacle to the College's wider access efforts. The current proposals were designed to address these concerns, as far as it was possible to do so. The President said that the discussion would be very helpful to the College's representations at the forthcoming Conference of Colleges discussion of these issues.

Helen Chadwick Fellowship

The College would also provide a sum of £500 towards travel expenses.
