Kendrew/Clarendon Scholarships

The Kendrew Funds were bequeathed to St John's College by Sir John Kendrew, a distinguished scientist and Nobel Prize winner, and former President of the College. In keeping with the spirit of Sir John Kendrew's international and humanitarian concerns, the funds are offered to a worldwide field of applicants from economically less developed countries, more specifically to students who are from countries whose Gross National Product (GNP) falls outside the highest 25% of countries in the world.

The Kendrew Scholarships are awarded in partnership with the Oxford Clarendon awards and cover University and College fees and living expenses for the duration of full fee liability. The living expenses grant for maintenance is in line with the UK research council rate.

The Kendrew / Clarendon Scholarships are available for all taught and research courses for which St John's accepts applications.
