**SEVEN COPIES** of your completed application must be submitted, which should include:

- □ Your application form. Please ensure that you have completed all sections of this form and set out on a separate sheet any further information that you think may be relevant to your application (no more than ONE SIDE of an A4 sheet of paper). (7 copies)
- □ A statement outlining your research of no more than 1,000 words. (7 copies)
- □ Your CV. (7 copies)

You may also return **ONE COPY** of the Equal Opportunities Monitoring Form, which enables the college to fulfil its obligations under relevant legislation, with your application. This form will be handled separately, and will not be available to those involved in the award of the studentships.

Applications must be returned by no later than **Monday 6<sup>th</sup> March 2017.** 

You must also ensure that your **TWO REFERENCES** are sent to the Graduate Officer, to be received by no later than **Monday** 6<sup>th</sup> **March 2017**.

- One of your references must be from your Supervisor.
- It is your responsibility to ensure that your references arrive before the deadline, so we recommend that you approach your referees as early as possible. You should take into consideration that many academics are extremely busy so they may not be available/able to produce a reference at short notice.
