- ❑ A statement outlining your research of no more than 1,000 words. (7 copies)
- ❑ Your CV. (7 copies)

You may also return **ONE COPY** of the Equal Opportunities Monitoring Form, which enables the college to fulfil its obligations under relevant legislation, with your application. This form will be handled separately, and will not be available to those involved in the award of the studentships.

Applications must be returned by no later than **Monday 6th March 2017**.

You must also ensure that your **TWO REFERENCES** are sent to the Graduate Officer, to be received by no later than **Monday 6th March 2017**.

- One of your references must be from your Supervisor.
- It is your responsibility to ensure that your references arrive before the deadline, so we recommend that you approach your referees as early as possible. You should take into consideration that many academics are extremely busy so they may not be available/able to produce a reference at short notice.
