

St John's Inspire Programme

Detailed programme outline

For Year 9	Attend an aspiration-raising event in Ealing/Harrow to learn more about studying at university and choosing subjects
For Year 10	Attend an exploring subjects event in Ealing/Harrow to learn more about the different subjects you can study at university
For Year 11	<p>Keep in touch with us online, to hear from Oxford academics and students about their work, and receive their tips on how they approached their studies and exams</p> <p>Come to Oxford for an academic taster day in either the autumn or spring half term, and find out what it is like to study here</p>
Year 12	<p>Apply to attend 5 Twilight sessions after school in Ealing and in Harrow</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Each session will include a 45 minute academic taster and 45 minutes information, advice and guidance or skills development (e.g. covering course choice and careers, presentation skills, personal statements, preparing for admissions tests) - We will aim to accommodate the particular academic interests of those taking part, e.g. arts/social science, maths/computer science/engineering, biology/medicine/biochemistry - A personal booklet will be supplied to bridge learning in individual sessions - including questions to encourage reflection on learning in sessions and capture any further research participants choose to follow up on - In preparation for 5th session, participants will be asked to follow up on an area of enthusiasm with some private research and give a short presentation to their peers <p>Followed by a summer residential in Oxford where participants will</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Participate in small group teaching - Get a taste of Oxford life - Present an aspect of their work at a 'graduation' event to which parents and teachers will be invited
Year 13	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Attend application and interview workshops in Ealing and Harrow
For parents and carers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Visit Oxford alongside year 11 pupils or come along to a Twilight session in Ealing or Harrow in Year 12 to find out about how university study works, the financial support available for students, and the support a college community provides - Visit Oxford at the end of our residential to celebrate the achievements of participants and ask any questions you may have about university applications
