1. Minutes and matters arising

The minutes of the meeting of Governing Body held on 29th November 2017 were **approved**.

2. <u>Domestic Committee</u>

The minutes of the meeting held on 24th January 2018 were received.

The Director of Development and Alumni Relations had proposed that alumni should be offered the opportunity to dine in Hall without the requirement of an invitation from a Fellow.

The Governing Body **agreed** to trial the proposal during Trinity Term and to gather feedback from students and information on take-up by alumni.

3. Educational Policy Committee

The minutes of the meeting held on 24th January 2018 were received.

The Senior Tutor noted that the annual academic feedback exercise was well underway and was well organised.

4. Any other business

The Acting President noted that it had been agreed in 2017 to replace the Scholars Dinner with a 2^{nd} Year Dinner, subject to consultation with the JCR. This year there would be both a Scholars Dinner and a 2^{nd} Year Dinner in Trinity Term and the JCR would be consulted about the retention of both dinners or their merger.

Professor Olszewska presented a paper on the need to reduce, and ideally to eliminate, singleuse plastics in College, noting the amount of plastic that ended up in the world's oceans and that only 44% of domestic waste in the UK is recycled. She noted the College's current initiatives to reduce the amount of plastic used, but highlighted the wide use of plastic water bottles and disposable coffee cups.

The Governing Body endorsed the paper and **agreed** that the issue should be discussed in Domestic Committee.
