

BAGLEY WOOD PERMITS

1. Permits to walk in Bagley Wood are available by return of the ‘tear off’ section of this form to

They are normally valid for two years from the date of issue, and are not transferable.

2. Permit holders may enter the wood over the stile at Bagley Close, or those on Bagley Wood Road, or over the footbridge by the sports field. Entry through the gates is not advisable since they are liable to be locked at any time.

3. Permits are issued for quiet enjoyment, recreation, or study. The woods are managed to yield forest produce, and to provide a habitat for indigenous wildlife. To this end the following rules are in place –
*No Musical Equipment
*No Motorised Vehicles
*No Bicycles
*No Picking/ Uprooting/Catching/Collecting of materials/plants/animals
*No Lighting of Fires
*No Carrying or Use of Weapons of any sort

4. CHILDREN MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT.

5. DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEAD.

A charge of **£ 5.00 inc VAT** is made for the issue of a permit. The fee may be waived if the permit is for research purposes.
